With reference to your online application dated 29.06.2013 on the subject cited above, I am directed to convey the sanction for Composite Provisional Affiliation for Secondary School Examination Under Switch Over Category of the Board for a period of three years w.e.f. 01.04.2014 to 31.03.2017.

The above sanction is subject to fulfillment of following conditions:-

1. The affiliation Code Number allotted to your school is 1130483. This may please be noted and quoted for any further correspondence with the Board.

2. The school will implement Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE) as per the schemes of the Board

upto Classes X vide Circular No. 39/20-09-2009 dated 20.09.2009 in the school.

3. The school will follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum prescribed by NCERT/CBSE and text books publishing by NCERT/CBSE for the Middle Classes. The school will follow syllabus and courses as per scheme of studies prescribed by the Board for Secondary/Sr. Secondary School Examination and changes made therein from time to time.

4. It is case of switch over from State Board; the school is required to withdraw its affiliation from such Board as dual affiliation is not permissible. Also State Board classes IX will not be continued w.e.f. 01.04.2014. However, for the Class X Examination to be held in the year 2015, the school will sponsor its students for State Board only.

5. The school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT

Govt from time to time.

6. The school will enroll students proportionate to the facilities available in the school as prescribed in the Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board which shall not in general exceed the optimum number as under :-

- 15. 5-6 names of persons not below the rank of Principal of Sr. Secondary School affiliated with the Board be recommended so that two of them may be approved by the Board as its nominee in the School Managing Committee. Of these 2-3 may be Principal of KV/JNV.
- 16. The accounts should be audited and certified by a Chartered Accountant and proper accounts statements should be prepared in the name of school, as per rules. A copy each of the Statements of Accounts should be sent to the Board every year.

  21. The school will open CBSE pattern classes IX w.e.f. 01.04.2014. Accordingly, 1st Batch of class X of the school will be appeared at the Board's Examination to be held in the year 2016.

- 28. As per rule no. 8.2 and 13.11, facilities for physically challenged student should be adequately provided and every school shall promote inclusion of student with disabilities/special needs in the normal school as per provisions of the 'Persons with Disabilities Act 1995'.
- 29. School infrastructure and teachers for examinations conducted by the board and evaluation of answer scripts should be made available as per rule no. 13.4.
- 30. As per rule no. 3.3 h (vi), every school should organize at least **one week training programme** for teachers every year in association with any teachers training institute recognized by the State or Central Government or by any agency identified by the Board.
- 31. Every secondary and senior secondary school shall appoint a person on full time basis for performing the duties of a **Health Weliness teacher** as per rule 53.5.
- Strict adherence to the provisions of Wild Life Protection Act while procuring plants and animals for the use in laboratories by the school must be made i.a.w. circular no 03 dated 21 May 2013.
- 33. As per rule 15.1 (d), the school will follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum prescribed by NCERT/ CBSE and text books published by NCERT/CBSE for the Middle classes as far as practicable or exercise extreme care while selecting books of **private publishers**. The contents must be scrutiny to preclude any objectionable content that hurts the feelings of any class, community, gender, religious group in society. If prescribed books found having such content, the school will have to take responsibility of such content. Provided that the school would put a list of such books prescribed by it on its website with the written declaration duly signed by the Manager and the principal to the effect that they have gone through the contents of the books prescribed by the school and own the responsibility.
- 34. As per RTE act 2009 and Chapter IX rule No. 53.2.2(a) and 53.3, a teacher appointed to teach Class I to V and VI to VIII should pass in the Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET)/ State Teacher Eligibility Test (TET) conducted by the appropriate Government in accordance with the guidelines framed by the NCTE for the purpose.
- 35. 5-6 names of persons not below the rank of Principal of Sr. Secondary School affiliated with the Board be recommended so that two of them may be approved by the Board as its nominee in the School Managing Committee (Of these 2-3 may be Principal of KV/JNV).
- 36. The school will create Reserve Fund as per the requirement of the Affiliation Bye Laws.
- It is mandatory for every affiliated school to become a member in the local Sahodaya of CBSE schools.
- 38. The Board would not allow any transfer of property/sale of school by one society/ Management/ Trust to another Society/Management/Trust through agreement/sale deed and the school shall not be closed down in the same premises. In case such transaction is effected explicitly or implicitly the Board shall withdraw its affiliation with immediate effect.
- 39. The school should not start Class XI/XII without written approval of the Board. The Board shall not be responsible for any consequences in case class XI/XII is started without following the Affiliation Bye Laws and obtaining the prior approval of the Board.
- 40. The school should keep a copy of Affiliation/ Examination Bye Laws for reference purpose also advised to visit CBSE websites www.cbseaff.nic.in&www.cbse.nic.in for updates.

In case of established violation of the provisions contained in Affiliation/Examination Bye laws of the Board, the school shall be liable for disaffiliation as per Rule No. 17 of Affiliation Bye-laws. 42.

The school shall enter into an agreement with the Board detailing the terms and

conditions for grant of affiliation, which will be binding on both the parties.

The school is required to follow the safety guidelines as issued by the Board vide 43. circular no. 19/2017 dated 12.09.2017 captioned "Safety of Children in schools".

Special conditions to be complied within three months:-44.

(a) Librarian is untrained. Therefore, the school is required to appoint trained and qualified Librarian and submit documentary evidences in support of the same.

(b) The school is required to furnish a copy of EPF Challan of latest month.

- (c) The school is required to procure more books relevant to improve the academic level of students in the library and keep at least 05 books per student in the library excluding text books, magazines etc. and intimate total books available in the library.
- (d) The school is required to appoint all the teachers (on permanent basis instead of adhoc) who are trained and qualified as per provisions of Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board and also maintain section teacher ratio i.e. 1.5 teachers per section at each level. Hence, a copy of revised staff statement is required to be submitted showing Name, Qualification, Designation, Date of Appointment, Date of Confirmation, classes assigned, experience
- (e) The school is required to submit a certificate/proof (of salary) issued/certified from the Competent Authority/Education Department of the State, to the effect that the school is paying salaries and other allowances to its staff as per State/Central Govt. norms and also submitted latest copy of acquittance-roll with complete details of all staff i.e. name, designation, pay-scale, salary details etc.

(f) The school is required to submit a certificate from the Bank i.e. Branch Manager through which the salaries are disbursed to the effect that the disbursement of salary is effected

through ECS mode.
